The School of Biological Sciences at Illinois State University in Normal, IL ([www.bio.illinoisstate.edu](http://www.bio.illinoisstate.edu)) invites applications for a nine month probationary tenure-track position in VIROLOGY at the level of Assistant Professor. We seek a colleague who studies molecular interactions of viruses with their non-human hosts or vectors, including molecular mechanisms of attachment, invasion, replication, persistence or other virus-host interactions. The School of Biological Sciences at Illinois State University is home to about 60 M.S. and Ph.D. students and over 600 undergraduate majors. A Ph.D. in Virology or related field and post-doctoral research are required; including research experience in virology. State law mandates demonstrable oral proficiency in the English language as a requirement for this position. Successful candidates will be expected to develop a nationally recognized research program, seek extramural funding, and contribute to teaching Microbiology (majors and non-majors courses), Virology and other courses in the Molecular and Cellular Biology program.
