CHECKLIST for PhD Dissertation Defense

Note: The Graduate School must approve your dissertation and give permission BEFORE you can take the Oral Dissertation Defense Examination.

- 1. Check the Graduate School website for submission deadlines for all forms the semester before you want to defend (in the Fall semester for Spring/Summer defenses and in the Spring semester for Fall defenses)
- 2. Successful completion of the combined qualifying exam and proposal defense (by start of 5th semester).
- 3. Successful completion of course requirements
- 4. Have two publications submitted to or accepted at a peer-reviewed journal
- 5. Schedule and Present a School Research seminar in the semester you wish to defend
- 6. Complete the Doctoral Degree Audit Form and submit to the Graduate Director, and apply for graduation
- 7. Submit the School of Biological Sciences Right to Defend Form and Graduate School Right to Defend Form to the Graduate Director
- 8. Have your dissertation draft authorized to be defended by (1) your Dissertation Committee and (2) the Graduate School
- 9. Schedule your defense at least one week (seven days) after your Right to Defend has been approved by the Graduate School
- 10. Submit an electronic copy of the approved dissertation draft to the Biological Sciences office at least one week (seven days) BEFORE the scheduled defense date.
- 11. Notify the Biological Sciences office of the Defense Examination date at least one week (seven days) BEFORE the scheduled defense date.
- 12. After you have passed the Dissertation Defense Examination an electronic final copy of the approved dissertation must be uploaded to ProQuest.
- 13. Submit the Outcome of Defense form and the Final Deposit checklist
